

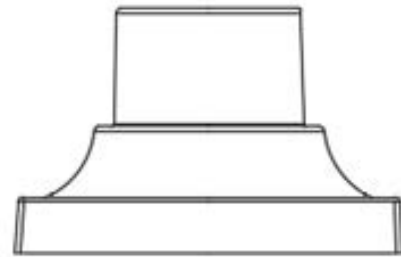
INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

All electrical connections must be made in accordance with all ordinances, and Local and National Electrical Codes.

STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS

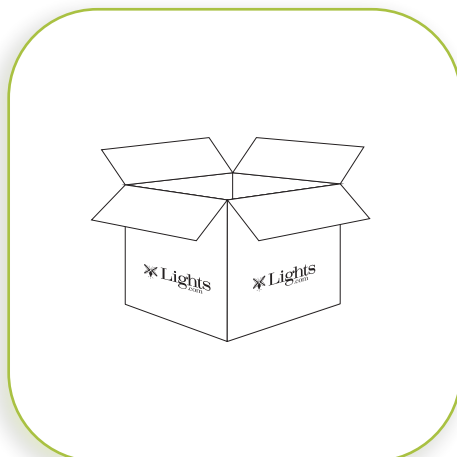
Before starting your installation, disconnect the power by turning off the circuit breaker or by removing the fuse at the fuse box. Just turning the light off at the light switch is not sufficient to prevent electrical shock.

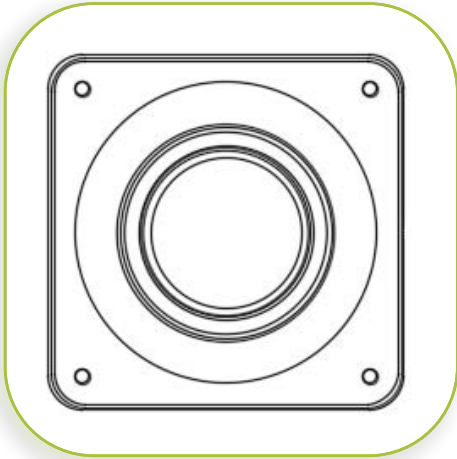

UNPACK PIER MOUNT

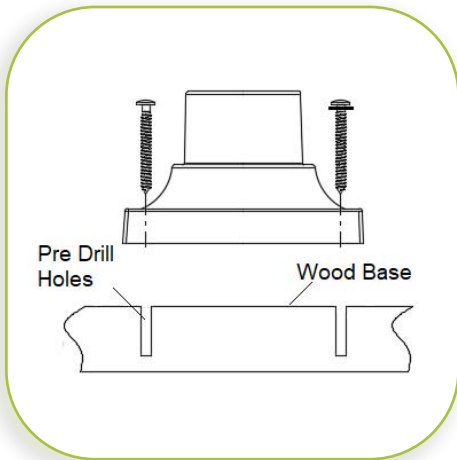

MARK DRILLING HOLES

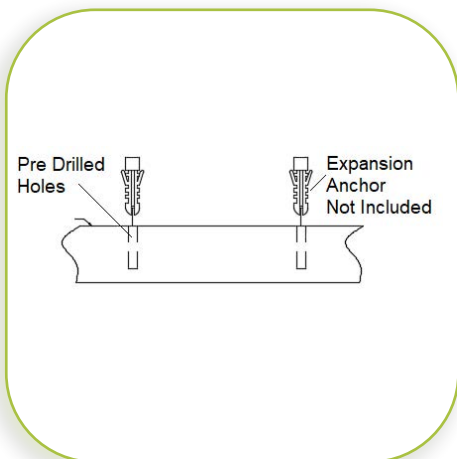
Using the pier mount as a template, place the pier mount flat where you are installing it, and mark your holes for drilling.

WOOD INSTALLATION

If installing with wood, we recommend using 14" Lag Bolts. These can be purchased at your local hardware store or home center. Drill a 3/16" pilot hole into the wood at each marking to prevent cracking.



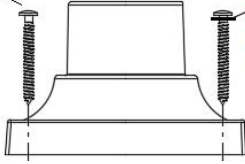

CONCRETE OR MASONRY INSTALLATION

If installing in concrete or masonry, we recommend using lead inserts or expansion nuts designed for masonry. These can be purchased at your local hardware store or home center. Follow manufacturers instructions for pilot holes.

INSTALL PIER MOUNT

Place the pier mount over the holes. Put silicone washers over the bolts and tighten to secure.

COMPLETE INSTALLATION

Once the pier mount is securely attached to the surface, run a bead of silicone around the edge.
