

## INSTRUCTIONS



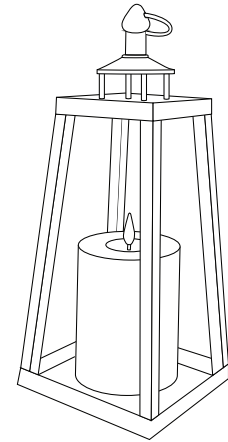
### IMPORTANT

Before using your Cooper Outdoor Lantern, please make sure that you carefully read through these instruction sheets.

Battery installation should only be performed by an adult. Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as recommended should be used. Battery leakage can cause corrosion and damage to this product so please remove non-functioning batteries immediately. Remove the batteries from product during long periods of non-use.

DO NOT DISPOSE OF IN FIRE. Please dispose at your local recycling facility.

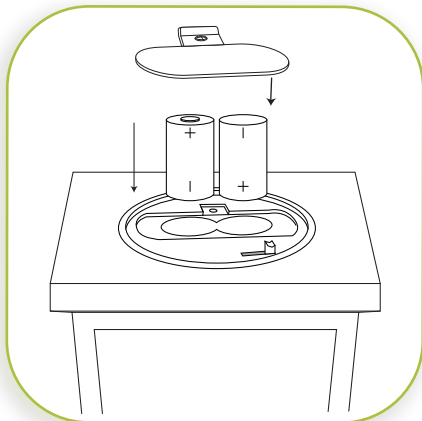

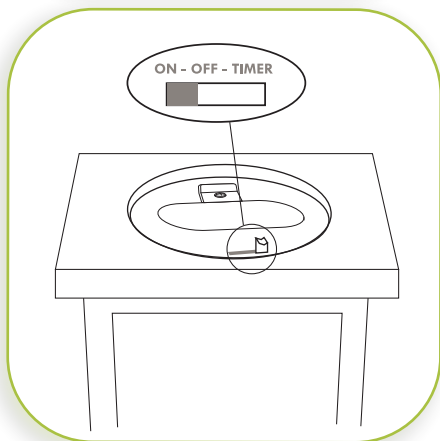

### BATTERY INSTALLATION

The lantern works with 2 x C batteries. The battery compartment is located on the bottom of the lantern. To install new batteries, unscrew the panel on the bottom. Batteries should be inserted with the correct polarity as indicated (+/-) and battery compartments secured before use.

### SWITCH OPTIONS

The ON/OFF/TIMER switch is located on the bottom of the lantern, below the battery compartment. To use the timer mode, move the switch to "TIMER" at your desired time. The timer will remain on for 6 hours and will turn on and off at the same time each day once set. To maximize battery life, manually turn off the lantern at the switch during long periods of non-use.
