## **GENERAL INFORMATION**

All electrical connections must be in accordance with all ordinances, Local and National Electrical Codes. These fixtures are intended for mounting to a standard 4" x 2-1/2" metal octagon box. The box must be directly supported by the building structure and U.L. Recognized.

## **STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS**

Before starting your installation, disconnect the power by turning off the circuit breaker or by removing the fuse at the fuse box. Just turning the light off at the light switch is not sufficient to prevent electrical shock.




## PREPARE FIXTURE AND INSTALL MOUNTING PLATE

If there is an existing fixture, remove it. Expose the supply wires from the J-box. Insert supply wires through the mounting plate. Secure mounting plate using the two Phillips head screws provided. Hand tighten to secure.




## **DETERMINE DESIRED HEIGHT**

Loosen screw on decorative nut below canopy with Flathead screwdriver. Slide canopy down 12" to 18" below desired height. Let sit while preparing the wiring. Cut power supply cord leaving 6" to 12" above desired height for minor adjustments.



# MAKE WIRE CONNECTIONS Connect the BLACK supply wire to the BLACK fixture wire and WHITE supply wire to the WHITE fixture wire. Secure with the supplied wire nuts. Either wrap the green wire around one of the protruding screws on the mounting plate


around one of the protruding screws on the mounting plate or connect it to the ground wire. Secure all wires with electrical tape (not supplied). Tuck all wires carefully into the J-Box.

## **INSTALL FIXTURE TO THE MOUNTING PLATE**


Position canopy over the mounting plate. Align the holes on the sides of the mounting plate with the two holes on the sides of the canopy and secure with the supplied screws.






## **REMOVING DECORATIVE RING**

Remove the decorative ring from the socket.



## **OPENING CAGE**


Open cage by unscrewing the decorative nut located on the bottom. This will detach the partial cage section from the cage base.

## ATTACHING CAGE


Attach cage base to the socket and secure in place with socket ring.





## **INSTALL BULB**

Install the bulb. MAXIMUM WATTAGE 60W. DO NOT EXCEED THE WATTAGE AS STATED ON THE WARNING LABEL.





## **SECURE CAGE BARS**

Reattach the removed partial cage section into cage base and secure with nut.



## RESTORE THE ELECTRICITY AND CHECK THE OPERATION OF YOUR NEW FIXTURE



Note: For the best lighting experience, we recommend using a dimmer. Not only does this allow you to create a great ambiance, it allows for energy savings and extends the life of the bulb.
